An international jury will vote for the best artist, whose masterpiece will be donated to the Committee of the Regions on behalf of all regional and local Czech communities. This masterpiece will remain in its premises as a tribute of the Czech Regions to the 15 year of CoR's activity in favour of the European Regions.

**25.2.-31.3. Prague – The city of Franz Kafka** Opened on February 24, the exhibition, which treats of mostly Kafka's life and his relation towards Prague, has scored a great acceptance. Among cca 170 distinguished guests was also Mrs. Helena Lukasová, the daughter of late Mr. Jan Lukas, a famous Czech photographer, who had portrayed Franz Kafka at several occasions and well-known writer Arnošt Lustig, whose contribution to the event was perceived as an exceptionally intelligent and witty message.
